SUBJECT: Industrial Relations Activities at Dryden Flight
Research Center

1. POLICY

Dryden is a tenant activity on a USAF installation. As such, close coordination with the USAF Regional Labor Advisor is required so that there is commonality of the labor policies between the two Agencies. Currently, the USAF Regional Labor Advisor is at Vandenburg AFB, Phone: (805) 734-8232, Ext. 67711.

Contracting Officers are to comply with the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 22 and its supplements concerning industrial labor relations matters.

NPG 5200.1 requires notification to NASA HQ of potential impasse or strike action. This applies to : (1) actions at contractor facilities with significant NASA contracts, (ii) contractors operating on DFRC as a result of a NASA contract, or (iii) on DFRC but not operating under a DFRC contract (e.g., a DOD contract). The Center Industrial Relations Advisor is responsible for this notification. The DFRC Procurement Officer is currently the DFRC Industrial Relations Advisor.

2. PURPOSE

This management instruction provides for the assignment of roles and responsibilities of the Industrial Relations Function at the Dryden Flight Research Center.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL LOCATION

The Chief, Acquisition Management Office is a direct report to the Center Director.
